



Make an Australian Citizenship Day chatterbox

Preparation

- Print the A4 page containing the chatterbox.
- Photocopy the required number.

Instructions

- 1. Cut out the square.
- 2. Turn the square over, and with the square face down, fold the four corners to the centre.
- 3. Turn over and fold all corners to the centre again.
- 4. Fold in half, crease, and repeat in the other direction.
- 5. Put your thumbs and index fingers in the pockets and you're ready to play the chatterbox.


How to play

- 1. Hold the chatterbox closed.
- 2. Ask someone to choose a number.
- 3. Open and close the chatterbox in different directions according to the number called out.
- 4. Ask the person to choose a number from the centre of the chatterbox.
- 5. Open and close the chosen number of times.
- 6. Ask the person to pick another number. Lift up the flap and read the question to them.
