



Client Deoxyribonucleic Acid (DNA) Collection Consent declaration

What we need you to do

Take an uncompleted copy of this form when you go to your sample collection appointment.

If collection is **outside Australia**, once the clinic has verified your identity, an officer of the Department of Home Affairs (the Department) will oversee you filling in the form and signing it. The officer will take two copies of the signed form (one for the file and one for you) and will give the original signed consent form to the sample collector to be forwarded along with the collected sample to the DNA testing laboratory.

If collection is **in Australia**, and there is no departmental witness, the client should obtain copies of the form they complete and sign before the sample collector.

Important information about privacy

Your personal information is protected by law, including the *Privacy Act 1988*. Important information about the collection, use and disclosure (to other agencies and third parties, including overseas entities) of your personal information, including sensitive information, is contained in form 1442i *Privacy notice*. Form 1442i is available from the Department's website www.homeaffairs.gov.au/allforms/ or offices of the Department. You should ensure that you read and understand form 1442i before completing this form.

The *Freedom of Information Act (FOI) 1982* also relates to personal information, whereby you can apply for access to documents containing your personal information.
