## Visas subject to condition 8501

Condition 8501<sup>1</sup> in Schedule 8 of the *Migration Regulations 1994* states that the visa holder must maintain adequate arrangements for health insurance while the holder is in Australia.

<sup>1</sup>**Mandatory (m)** conditions apply to the visa by operation of law at the time of visa grant. **Discretionary (d)** conditions are imposed by the delegate as part of the decision to grant, once the visa is granted the condition(s) has been lawfully imposed and cannot be revisited with a view to removing the condition from the visa.

<sup>2</sup> Condition 8501 can only be imposed on a Visitor visa granted in certain streams or in certain circumstances.

Condition 8501 is applicable to certain bridging visas (BV) in specific circumstances.
